

Arizona Mission Offering Game

To set up the game: Print multiple copies of the first eight cards (page 2). Print one copy of the Start, Finish, and Fun Fact cards. Cut apart the cards. Stack the Fun Fact cards together. Lay the game cards in a row or circle, in random order, between the Start and Finish cards.

To play the game: Collect a game marker for each player. Try different buttons, coins, or pebbles. Take turns rolling a die and moving the indicated spaces. Follow any directions when you land on a space. The first player to reach the Finish wins the game.

Move ahead 1.

Move back 1.

Take another turn.

Lose a turn.

Safe.

Go back to Start.

Take a Fun Fact card.
